Mission

To provide a \$2500.00 scholarship to an individual Student Pilot in passionate pursuit of their Private Pilot's certificate.

Summary

The EAA Chapter 643 of Sky Manor Airport has developed a scholarship, in the form of financial assistance, to a student pilot in current pursuit of their Private Pilot Certificate. The purpose of the scholarship is to grow the general aviation community by assisting an additional pilot, who shares our passion, to complete their training. A \$2500.00 scholarship is available for 2019. All scholarship funds awarded will be made payable directly to the students flight school.

Application deadline is December 31, 2019.

Criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria for scholarship consideration:

- Must be in pursuit of Private Pilot Certificate
- Must have a letter of recommendation from the flight instructor providing primary training
- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Must complete a 2019 Donald R. Gordon Memorial Scholarship Application
- Must be in good financial status with flight the school providing training

Checkpoints

- First checkpoint - \$1,000 will be provided to the flight school for the benefit of the student following first solo.
- Second checkpoint - \$1,000 will be provided to the flight school for the benefit of the student following successful completion of FAA Private Pilot knowledge exam.
- Third Checkpoint - \$500 will be provided to the student for payment of their check ride following successful completion pre-check ride preparation & instructor endorsement.
